ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY *Mon., July 27th!!!* LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IF IN THE HANDS OF THE SECRETARY NO LATER THAN *8/01/2009*, AND ACCOMPANIED BY A \$25.00 LATE FEE. ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER THE EXTENDED DEADLINE WILL BE RETURNED. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

If entry fees are not mailed with your entry form, it will be returned. In order to enter this rodeo, each contestant's family must have turned in a \$75 or more sponsorship donation, earned twenty (20) work points prior to the August Rodeo and earn three work points at the August Rodeo; contestants must have paid dues, signed the liability release, have report card, & birth certificate on file. Contestants not earning a total of twenty work-points must pay a \$300.00 fine prior to participation in the rodeo. Contestants not earning 3 work points at the August Rodeo will not receive prizes.

(Workers: must wear long sleeve shirts, jeans, & closed toed shoes)

Please coordinate with your partners (Team Ropers, Ribbon Ropers/Runners (in Jrs., Sr., & adult age groups), before mailing your entry blank to the secretary. If two of you are riding the same horse, a special request **MUST BE ON YOUR ENTRY BLANK**. You will not be moved once the draw has been made.

People are not allowed in the arena during an event unless that person has been assigned to the work point book for that event, a contestant member who is competing in an event and it is their time to compete, a member of the Board of Directors, or someone who has special permission from the Board of Directors (such as the photographer).

This rodeo is one go and a short round. The short round is Saturday, August 8th, at 2:00 PM. We will also have an Awards Dinner Banquet to follow under the pavilion behind the arena.

NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE ARENA AREA!!

Long sleeve shirts are required. Cowboy hats are optional. No ball caps in the arena. See FBCYRA Rulebook or website fbcyra.com for more information on the dress code and the Rodeo rules.

Bareback, Bull Riding, and Jr. Steer Riding will be a Jack Pot event in lieu of Prizes.
Back gates will be "CLOSED" for all roping events.

Effective, January 1, 1997, a negative Coggins Test will be required by law to enter any horse event, show, rodeo, etc. It is the contestant's responsibility to have the negative test (must be an original, no copies will be accepted) results available at all rodeos for inspection. The Texas Animal Commission will make random checks. Not having the test paper will result in the contestant being disqualified and the possibility of your animal being quarantined.
